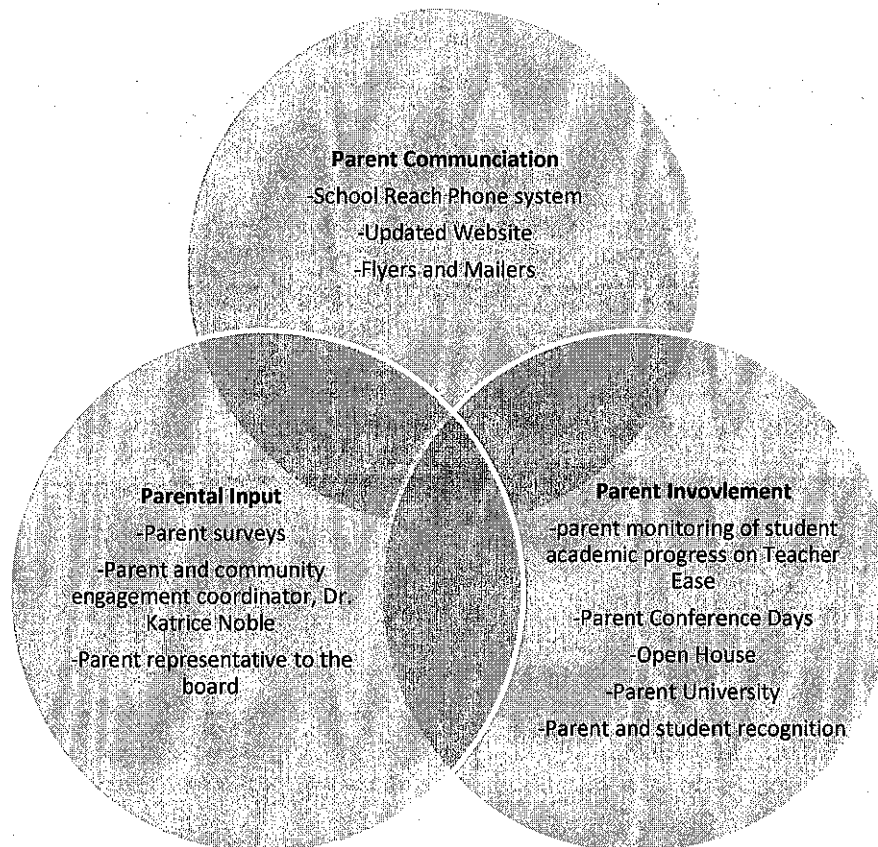


Lift for Life Academy High School

- The Academy's comprehensive performance plan will be available to parents by the time of the first scheduled parent teacher conference night. The Comprehensive Performance plan includes strategies and action steps for improving the school's performance (similar to a Comprehensive School Improvement Plan).
- Includes in the comprehensive school improvement plan will be strategies that will be funded with Title I funds. As the school transitions to schoolwide pool funding this may be adjusted.

Parent University

Parent University provides parent the opportunity to support students and the school's learning community through a variety of activities. In addition, Parent University is also used to help educate parents and improve the wellbeing of families through parent/community education. Communications

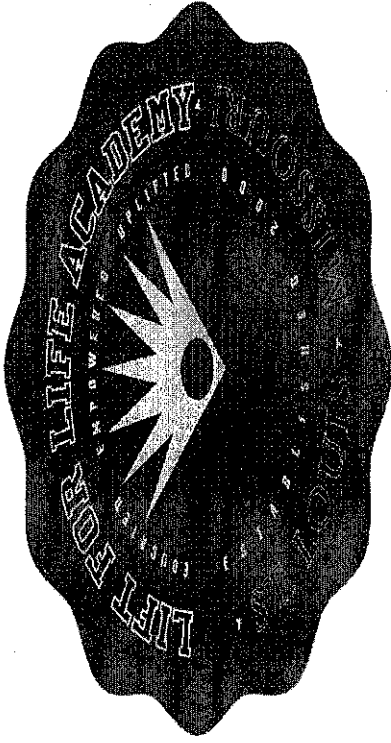
- Lift for Life Academy Middle and High School are committed to maintaining a resourceful website.
