Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s):

The goal of the *No Child Left Behind Act* (NCLB) of 2001 is to ensure that all children in this country receive a quality education. Under NCLB, each state is required to assess all schools to determine if each school has made adequate yearly progress (AYP) toward meeting the academic testing standards set by the state. If the school has not made AYP for two consecutive years, it is considered "in need of improvement."

Based on the results of this year's academic testing in reading and math, your child's school, Lift For Life Academy, did not make adequate yearly progress for the following reasons:

- Failure to reach state performance targets in Communication Arts and Mathematics on the Missouri Assessment Program (MAP).

Lift For Life Academy's scores on the MAP are below the state average in Communication Arts and Math; however, the school is outperforming many schools located within the City of St. Louis. School Choice:

In accordance with the provisions of the No Child Left Behind Act, schools that do not make adequate yearly progress are required to offer a "choice option" to parents. The choice option allows parents to request a transfer of their student(s) to a school that did meet AYP. Your child is eligible for public school choice options under the NCLB Act. There are two options available for your child:

1. Remain at the current school.
2. Request transfer to a school in your district that has made adequate academic progress.

St. Louis magnet schools and county school along with other charter schools are not available for the "school choice" selection. In addition, no non-magnet middle or high schools in the City of St. Louis met AYP in both Communication Arts and Math. For more information about the school choice, please contact the school's administrative offices.

Supplemental Educational Services (SES)

Under the provisions of the No Child Left Behind Act, schools that do not achieve AYP must offer Supplemental Educational Services (SES) to their students. Included with this

Once request forms have been submitted, the school will work with the providers to arrange services. Some of the providers parents choose may not decide to work with the school. If you have any questions, then please contact the school's administration office.

School Improvement:

Because of this designation, the school must develop a plan for improvement. One important component of this plan will be parent involvement in both the development and implementation of the plan. We encourage you to become involved with your child's school to support school improvement. Listed below are just a couple of things parents can do to assist us in our improvement goals:

- Attend all scheduled parent-teacher conferences.
- Monitor the academic progress of students on the computer using Ed-line.
- Inform teachers and administrators that you are willing to volunteer, correspond regularly and attend classes with your student.
- Make suggestions to the teachers and administrators on how to help your child achieve and have an overall successful school experience.
