Timeline for the Implementation of Supplemental Educational Services (SES) 2010-2011

August 2010	-1 st Letter to parents informing them of school choice and SES free tutoring opportunities.
September 2010	-Any willing SES vendor may distribute information describing their educational program at the school's Open House night. -2010-2011 SES letters and parent signup forms will be posted to the school's website. -The purpose and steps for signing up students for SES will be presented to the parent advisory council.
October 2010	-The federal programs coordinator will collect and identify parent requests for SES services by firm. SES firms identified by parents will be contacted.
November 2010	-The school/district will enter into contractual agreements for the providing of SES services to students. -1 st session, including pre-testing, of students to occur in November.
December 2010	-Regularly scheduled SES tutoring session begin.
January 2011	-2 nd Letter to parents informing them of SES free tutoring opportunities. -Parent notification flyers of current SES services being provided.
February 2011	-The parents of all SES students will have received at least one progress report.
March 2011	-Most SES tutoring sessions conclude. -State MAP testing begins.
April 2011	-Arranged make-up sessions.
May 2011	-All SES providers give the school/district end-of-program results for participating students.
June 2011	-SES results shared with parent advisory council.
July 2011	
August 2011	-Student participation and MAP performance all SES students is documented and distributed to the parent advisory council and administration. -Participation and performance information overview posted to the school/district's website.
