



Lift for Life Academy Learning Pathway Options



LFLA Families can choose from two options:

Option 1: Intermittent Blended Learning--LFLA will adjust to appropriate tier based upon Covid-19 factors (See below for descriptions)

Tier 1: In-person learning

Low to minimal spread (level of community spread of COVID-19 as determined by local health officials)

All grade levels attend in-person with safety and social distancing measures in place

Tier 2: Blended learning

Moderate spread (level of community spread of COVID-19 as determined by local health officials)

Students attend in-person two days a week and attend virtually two days a week. Half of students in building at a time

Tier 3: Remote learning

Substantial spread (level of community spread of COVID-19 as determined by local health officials)

Students attend 100% remotely 4 days a week

Option 2: 100% Virtual Learning at Home

Students have the option of selecting a 100% virtual online pathway. This program will be 100% self-paced and student and parent driven. It will run through the state-approved virtual learning platform, not the teacher-driven google classrooms. Students who choose this option must remain on this path for at least one full semester.
