Here are the following dates for our visits to the library, where children ages 4-18 can get a free eye exam:

- .October 12th-14th Lewis and Clark Library
- .October 19th-21st Indian Trails Library
- .October 26th-28th Florissant Valley Library
- .November 2nd and 4th Jamestown Bluffs Library

All of the above visits will begin at 9:00 AM, but we recommend arriving by 8:30 or earlier since we will only provide eye exams to the first 15 children who arrive that day.

If your student is able to get an eye exam from a different provider, they can get glasses for us for free by filling out the attached form.

Mobile Vision Clinic

Eye Thrive is offering free vision screenings, eye exams and glasses at St. Louis County Library branch and community center locations per the calendar below. These services will be offered beginning at 9:00 a.m. each day. Eye exams will be administered on board the Mobile Vision Clinic. Capacity is limited to up to 15 eye exams per day. Line numbers will be assigned based on the order of arrival.

Any child age 4-18 is eligible for the vision screening, and if required, an eye exam and glasses. All services are provided free of charge. A parental consent form must be completed prior to the eye exam.

COVID-19 Adjustments:

- All children must pass a COVID-19 screening prior to vision screening and eye exam.

- Eye Thrive will provide masks for children during vision screenings and eye exams.
- Everyone on-site over the age of two must wear a face mask at all times.
