The Highly Qualified Status of Teachers
Notice to Parents (August 17, 2021)

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Dear Parent(s) and Guardian(s):

Under the provisions of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), school districts receiving federal assistance in the form of Title I monies must state the highly-qualified status of teachers. The law defines highly-qualified as being a Missouri state certified teacher in the grade level and subject area in which the teacher is teaching. In addition, teachers not considered highly-qualified are required to have a teaching mentor. Please speak with your building principal or the federal programs coordinator for additional information.
